Is the head instructor and owner of the Golden Pyramid Martial Arts Center.

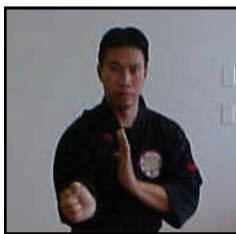
Mr. Kujawinski started his martial arts training in 1968. Shihan Kujawinski holds an 8th degree black belt with the Kwanmukan and the Eastern USA Martial Arts Association. He also holds a 6th degree black belt in Kajukenbo, 4th degree black belts in Ju Jitsu, & Tae Kwon Do, 3rd degree black belt in Kobudo and Chanbara. Mr. Kujawinski holds several martial arts titles including shihan, sigung and sensei. He is on the executive board of Eastern USA Martial Arts Association, the Shihan board of the Kwanmukan, and is a member of the Black Belt Hall of Fame. Shihan Kujawinski spent 10 years teaching elementary school where he was nominated twice as *Outstanding Young Educator*. He has also taught self defense courses at Cuyahoga Community College.



Shihan Michael Piaser holds an 8th degree black belt in Ju Jitsu as well as black belts in Judo, KwanMuKan Karate-do, Chang Moo Kwan and Kobudo. Mr. Piaser is former President of the United States Ju Jitsu Federation and Chairman of the USJFF Referees' Committee. He has traveled all over the world representing Ju Jitsu. The Golden Pyramid Martial Arts Center is fortunate to have Shihan Piaser as its Ju Jitsu Instructor.



Sensei John Arnold began his training in 1988 under Hanchi George Anderson. Mr. Arnold currently teaches adult karate classes at the Golden Pyramid. He received his 3rd degree black belt in 2010 from Shihan Kujawinski. Sensei Arnold continues his in martial arts studying Kwanmukan and Kajukenbo, Karate and Wu Tai Chi.



Sifu Donald Permadi has studied the martial arts for more than 30 years. He is a disciple of the Grand Zen Master Satyadharma. He has trained under the Grand Master Satyadharma's direct supervision since 1997 in Indonesia. Sifu Permadi is only the 2nd person to achieve the red belt or sash from Grand Master Satyadharma. Grand Master Satyadharma is the 96th Patriarch of Shao Lin Sze. His teacher was the 95th Zen Patriarch Pen Wu Ch'an Shi (1883-1964), who was the third disciple of the 94th Zen Patriarch Dong Ch'an Ch'an Shi (1837-1910) from a direct line of the First Zen Patriarch, Bodhidharma. Sifu Permadi is Chief Instructor of the Shao Lin Kung Fu program.



Sifu Lou LaJoe has studied both Wu style and Yang style Tai Chi along with Northern Longfist and Wing Chun Kung Fu. He is experienced in straight sword, broad sword, spear and push hands. He holds both a black sash in Chinese Martial Arts and a 1st degree black belt in Tae Kwan Do. Sifu LaJoe is the Chief Instructor of the Golden Pyramid's Tai Chi Program.



Sibak Margaret Hudy has studied various martial arts. She holds a 2nd degree black belt in Kajukenbo, a 2nd degree black belt in Kwanmukan, and a black sash in the Golden Pyramid's Chinese Martial Arts. In 2009 she was inducted into the Eastern U.S.A. Martial Arts Hall of Fame as "Outstanding Female Competitor of the Year". She is a Northcoast Chinese forms and weapons champion, All-Japan Karate Academy forms and weapons champion, American Warrior 1st place forms and weapons, Dana Abbott Regional Chanbara 1st place, Karate Institute points tournament 1st place weapons and forms winner. She is currently continuing her training in Ju Jitsu, Kali and Wu Tai Chi. Sibak Hudy is Chief Instructor for the Golden Pyramid's House of the Dragon Chinese Martial Arts Program.



Guro Martin Johnson has 20 years of experience in martial arts studying Shaolin Gung Fu, Tae Kwon Do, knife fighting and Kali. Guro Johnson has studied Kali with Punong Guro Tony Marcial in the Marcial Tirada method of Kali. He has also studied with Edgar Sultie, founder of Lameco Eskrima and well known martial arts author. Under the tutelage of Master of Arms James Keating, Mr. Johnson furthered his skills in knife fighting. Holding both black belts and black sashes, Guro Johnson is able to teach the art of Kali so that it can be applied and blended into your own martial arts style.



Sibak Chris Grzlewski holds a 2nd degree black belt in Kajukenbo. He has studied Iaido, Kali, Wu Tai Chi and Kung Fu. Sibak Grzlewski teaches many of the youth karate classes at the Golden Pyramid. Sibak Grzlewski is a recipient of the Adam Charles Ports Foundation for Martial Arts Scholarship. He is a member of the E.U.S.A. Martial Arts Hall of Fame, and has won many martial arts trophies in Chanbara, Iaido, weapons, and forms.
